

Singapore energy storage project

Vena Energy and Shell have secured conditional approval from the Singapore Energy Market Authority to import 400 MW of renewable energy from the Riau Islands. Vena Energy's Indonesia projects include a planned 2 GW solar and 8 GWh battery energy storage system on the Riau Islands, expected to deliver 2.6 TWh of green energy to Singapore annually.

In 2021, under the Low-Carbon Energy Research Funding Initiative (LCER FI), the Singapore government awarded a total of S\$55 million to 12 research, development, and demonstration projects on low-carbon energy technology solutions in hydrogen (4 projects) and CCUS (8 projects) to boost the decarbonisation of the power and industry sectors.

Singapore-based Sun Cable has revealed the \$30 billion Australia-Asia PowerLink (AAPL) project, which will supply electricity to Singapore from a massive solar PV farm and battery energy storage facility in Australia's Northern Territory, is the "first of many" megaprojects it is looking to develop.

The AAPowerLink project is set to deploy between 17GW and 20GW of solar capacity and between 36.42GWh and 42GWh of energy storage to connect Australia's Northern Territory with Singapore via 4,300km of subsea cable and supply power to the territory's capital, Darwin, and the surrounding region.
