

# Single reservoir energy storage power generation

Pumped storage hydropower (PSH) is a type of hydroelectric energy storage. It is a configuration of two water reservoirs at different elevations that can generate power as water moves down from one to the other (discharge), passing through a turbine. The system also requires power as it pumps water back into the upper reservoir (recharge).

A pumped storage project would typically be designed to have 6 to 20 hours of hydraulic reservoir storage for operation at. By increasing plant capacity in terms of size and number of units, hydroelectric pumped storage generation can be concentrated and shaped to match periods of highest demand, when it has the greatest value.

Correspondingly, the geothermal power generation cost ranges from \$ 0.086 / kWh to \$ 0.095 / kWh, which is a little higher than the conventional power generation cost. Double-flash or flash-organic Rankine cycle is suggested to be installed for geothermal power generation if more electricity is needed.
