

Silicon Valley Power (SVP) has selected Ameresco, a Massachusetts-based renewable energy developer, to build a 50MW/200 megawatt-hour (MWh) battery energy storage system (BESS) in Santa Clara, California, US. The BESS project, known as Kifer Energy Storage, will offer additional local area capacity with a reliable and flexible electrical system.

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The company said it deployed the largest battery energy storage system in Slovakia back in 2020, another 432kWh system, for energy supplier G& E Trading. However, that was later eclipsed by a 5.3MW/2.9MWh system that Switzerland-headquartered firm Leclanché installed for frequency regulation at a medium voltage grid of a natural gas plant ...

The Mochovce Nuclear Power Plant (Slovak: Atómové elektrárne Mochovce, abbr. EMO) is a nuclear power plant located between the towns of Nitra and Levice, on the site of the former village of Mochovce, Slovakia. Two up-rated 470 MW (originally 440 MW) reactors plus a 471 MW VVER 440 reactor are presently in operation, with a fourth of the same type under construction.

Ipel Pumped storage hydropower plant is a 600MW hydro power project. It is planned on Ipel river/basin in Banska Bystrica, Slovakia. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently at the permitting stage. It will be developed in a single phase.

In February 2023, unit 3"s power was increased to 35% of overall capacity, then to 55% in March, 75% in July and 90% in August. The Slovak Nuclear Regulatory Authority told Slovenské Elektrárne it could now raise reactor output to 100%. The company will perform a 144-hour trial run with power at maximum capacity.
