

Capacity Value (\$): The monetary value of the contribution of a generator (conventional, renewable, or storage) to balancing supply and demand when generation is scarce. Operating Reserves and Ancillary Services: To maintain reliable power system operations, generation must exactly match electricity demand at all times.

Czech Republic passed a new legislation that 5 kW energy storage capacity was necessary for 1 kW PV installation, and US\$ 20.3 million was invested as government incentives [20]. An estimated 431 MWh energy storage (excluding pumped storage) was installed in 2017 in US, with up to 234 MWh in the first quarter [2].

PHES comprises about 96% of global storage power capacity and 99% of global storage energy volume. Some countries have substantial PHES capacity to help balance supply and demand (figure 3). In public power, exploration of newer storage options is happening in every region and at utilities big and small. As of August 2021, the Public Power Energy Storage Tracker lists 74 projects that are already online, ranging from batteries with a few kilowatts to pumped hydro with thousands of megawatt-hours in energy capacity.

In Fig. 2 it is noted that pumped storage is the most dominant technology used accounting for about 90.3% of the storage capacity, followed by EES. By the end of 2020, the cumulative installed capacity of EES had reached 14.2 GW. The lithium-iron battery accounts for 92% of EES, followed by NaS battery at 3.6%, lead battery which accounts for about 3.5%, ...

We also need a mixture of energy storage that is very-short-term (milliseconds to seconds) to stabilise the electricity grid and control voltage and phase, short-term (hours) to stabilise electrical energy systems and provide uninterruptible power supply, and long-term (days to years) to resupply the energy system.
