



Solar energy storage in Mexico

The Foxtail Flats Solar and Storage agreements will bring 170 MW of solar power from the Four Corners Area as an energy resource for Los Alamos County, as well as 80 MW of battery storage. This project was approved by Council in February 2024.

To accelerate investments and promote the formation of a storage market, Mexico should introduce technology-push and market-pull policies simultaneously. Procurement targets could be used if policymakers decided that energy storage is a short-term priority, as in the case of the US.

Utility Public Service Company of New Mexico's (PNM) plan to procure energy from 950MW of solar and storage facilities by 2022 and replace its retiring 562MW San Juan Generating Station coal plant has been handed a boost.

The market is favorable for solar energy projects thanks to low equipment costs, strong renewable energy policies, and several national solar power programs. Solar panels in Mexico cost an average of \$3.07 per watt, and we expect this to decrease further as the development of solar becomes more commonplace.

As Mexico expands its solar market, we expect companies to increase their investment in battery storage operations to optimize the solar power generated across the country. But Mexico will have to improve its regulatory framework for renewable energy for the industry to become more efficient and attractive to investors.

A year ago, technology firm Honeywell announced it would deploy a 20MW/80MWh lithium-ion battery storage project for a PNM solar farm. The move by the New Mexico Senate follows hot on the heels from the lower house in Michigan proposing its own legal energy storage target, of 2.5GW of deployments by 2030.

Solar PV was successful in both, securing 1,691 MW of the 2,085 MW auctioned in the first and 1573 MW of 3473 MW in the second auction. [6] In 2013, 22% of the installed electricity generation capacity in Mexico was from renewable sources. The majority, 18.1% coming from hydroelectricity, 2.5% from wind power and 0.1% from solar PV.
