Power generation and its storage using solar energy and hydrogen energy systems is a promising approach to overcome serious challenges associated with fossil fuel-based power plants.

Large-scale thermal energy storage (TES) is a key component of concentrating solar power plants (CSP), offering energy dispatchability by adapting the electricity power production to the demand curve [1]. The industry is looking for more economical and efficient TES systems, especially for process heat applications between 150-250 °C.

This funding program seeks to develop and demonstrate the production of fuels using concentrating solar thermal (CST) energy to deliver heat to the system. Thermal energy storage is a family of technologies in which a fluid, such as water or molten salt, or other material is used to store heat. This thermal storage material is then stored in an insulated tank until the energy



is needed. The energy may be used directly for heating and cooling, or it can be used to generate electricity.

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
