The Boksburg explosion took place on 24 December 2022, when a fuel tanker carrying liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) exploded underneath a railway bridge in Boksburg, in the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality in Gauteng, South Africa, [1] with a death toll of 41 people as of 18 January 2023. [2] Nearby infrastructure was damaged by the explosion.

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On Wednesday, the South African-based Apollo substation, owned by state-owned power utility Eskom, suffered an explosion in one of its transformers. The Mozambican Cahora Bassa hydroelectric dam exports electricity to the Apollo substation located in Centurion, close to Pretoria.

South Africa is transitioning toward a low carbon economy. The government has adopted the Integrated Resource Plan 2019 (IRP) and intends to add more than 20,000 MW of wind and solar energy generation capacity, with their share in the country's energy mix growing from the current 3% to 24% by 2030.
