The energy storage landscape includes short- and long-duration energy storage solutions. Short-duration energy storage (SDES), also known as short-term energy storage, is defined as any storage system that is able to discharge energy for up to 10 hours at its rated power output.

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Short term energy storage requires technologies suited to a daily charge and discharge cycle with low energy leakage, reasonably high roundtrip efficiency, durability, sufficient resources, low carbon credentials, and low cost per kWh storage capacity. The heat from solar energy can be stored by sensible energy storage materials (i.e., thermal oil) [87] and thermochemical energy storage materials (i.e., $\text{CO}_3\text{O}_4/\text{CoO}$) [88] for heating the inlet air of turbines during the discharging cycle of LAES, while the heat from solar energy was directly utilized for heating air in the work of [89].

Compared with the long-term systems, the short-term heat storage system has the following advantages: more space and time saving, better flexibility, smaller heat loss, and more suitable for small-scale use. The short-term heat storage system has a charge and discharge period of a few days and it is therefore widely known as diurnal heat storage.
