

# Swedish power plant energy storage investment

Energy in Sweden - Facts and Figures 2023 present the supply and use of energy, energy prices, energy markets and fuel markets in Sweden, as well as some international statistics. Swedish battery manufacturer Northvolt has secured a \$5bn (Skr52.31bn) non-recourse project financing deal for the expansion of the first circular gigafactory in the country.. Furthermore, the Swedish Energy Agency's most recent analysis indicates that a large number of power plants will exceed their age limit by 2045. The combined production of these power plants is 100 TWh per year.

Today, most of Sweden's electricity is produced by hydropower or nuclear power. In 2012, the country produced 166 TWh, of electricity, of which 47% was produced by hydropower and 39% by nuclear power, while thermal power production (primarily CHP using biomass/black liquor, municipal waste or peat) accounted for about 10%.
