The Tesla Powerwall battery capacity is 13.5 kWh. You can stack up to 10 of them together for a grand total of 135 kWh. There isn't anything wrong with those numbers by any means -- they just aren't the highest numbers you can achieve with home battery backups. Most competitors have options that are larger on a per-unit basis than the Powerwall.

The Tesla Powerwall 2 is a powerful energy storage appliance on its own, but that power is scaled up with Tesla's ability to bundle Powerwalls together virtually into larger energy storage units.

Tesla installation adds an additional \$1,100 but may not be available in your area. Third-party installation can add an additional \$2,000-\$3,000 depending on factors such as where you live. Most homeowners only need one or two Powerwalls for energy storage, but some require three or more to fully go off-grid.

The Tesla brand earns a 4.5 out of 5 star rating on the EnergySage Marketplace, based on more than 600 reviews. Most of those reviews are about Tesla installers rather than the equipment itself. But since you would be getting a Powerwall installed by a certified Tesla pro, that rating bodes well for your installation experience.

The Powerwall was first introduced by Tesla in 2015, with its Powerwall 2 sibling being announced in

October 2016. Now, Tesla is revising the Powerwall once again, according to CEO Elon Musk, who detailed the improvements Tesla plans to make to the energy storage device in the coming months.
