However, concrete does not hold up well under the heavy abuse of a high-volume transfer station and is prone to cracking and fracturing. In high-volume transfer stations, the surface of the tipping floor can lose from 1/4 to 1 inch of concrete every year depending on waste stream and equipment used.

Tipping floor dumping transfer station. This is similar to a direct dumping station except it has additional space for trucks to discharge their waste on a concrete tipping floor for inspection and emergency storage. A front loader with a bucket is required to push the waste from the floor into the transfer trailer. Pit-dumping station.

# Transfer station energy storage floor

A push pit transfer station's name defines the method used. The facility is designed with an elevated tipping floor, typically about 15' above the pit floor where the transfer trailer sits. Above the transfer trailer is an open hole in the floor roughly 45' long x 7' wide.

The tipping floor of a solid waste transfer station plays a critical role in waste management operations, yet its importance in design and maintenance is often undervalued. Tipping floors are not just a normal slab-on-grade, but rather are subject to a relentless barrage of abrasion and chemical attack as solid waste is collected for transport ...
