In the energy storage elements the constraint is expressed as a differential or integral relationship, that defines the element as having integral or derivative causality. For example, a mass element m has an elemental relationship that is normally written in the form = m.

The controllable component energy constraint of the energy storage element ranges between the minimum and maximum output, and the energy constraint needs to satisfy the capacity constraint of the energy storage at each moment and maintain the same power state at the end of the period as at the beginning. serves to identify dependent and independent energy storage elements. If, in the process, any energy storing element is assigned derivative causality, then that is a dependent storage element.
