

The San Diego battery facility came online in 2020 and was billed at the time by grid infrastructure developer LS Power as the largest battery energy storage project in the world. Using LG Chem Lithium-ion cells, it beat the previous record held by a 150MW project in Australia, although has since been surpassed by other facilities.

In recent years, fire and explosion accidents in energy storage power stations have been common, according to statistics, there have been more than 30 fires in energy storage power stations in the world in the past year. Since August 2017, there have been 29 fire accidents in energy storage power stations in South Korea.

Medupi power station owner Eskom reported on 9 August that there had been an explosion on the Unit 4 generator at approximately 10:50 pm on 8 August. It is suspected that this was the cause of a trip on Unit 5 of the 6 unit coal fired plant.
