

Despite the decrease in the energy storage system (ESS) cost, ESS remains expensive, and the upfront investment required is difficult to overcome without government support. The United Kingdom energy storage systems market is segmented by type and application.

Compressed air energy storage (CAES) is a promising energy storage technology, mainly proposed for large-scale applications, that uses compressed air as an energy vector.

The UK has 2.4GW/2.6GWh of operational energy storage across 161 sites, with 20.2GW additional approved in planning. The UK is deploying increasing amounts of new utility energy storage capacity each year. The total pipeline for UK energy storage is now at 61.5GW across 1,319 sites.
