In an effort to harness the power of ocean waves, engineers designed and built a floating "power buoy" that measures 8 feet across, 10 feet wide, and 18 feet long. The buoy uses the upward and downward motion of waves, combined with the weight of a metal plate, to move a hydraulic piston, resulting in electricity.

You pump water to a reservoir located at a higher altitude when energy supply is higher than demand, and then release the water to drive turbines located downstream when demand is high. In underwater pumped storage, the power plant is already on the water, an enclosed vessel containing water is installed on the seafloor.

When the energy is needed, the bladder releases and, driven by the pressure of the seawater above it, squeezes its water back down to the reservoir, spinning turbines on the way to generate electricity that's fed out into the grid. A diagram of the Ocean Battery system.

Currently, there are two feasible types of energy storage technologies available for scalable energy storages, namely pumped hydro energy storage and compressed air energy storage (CAES) [7].CAES is a kind of promising energy storage technology thanks mainly to its long service life, less geographic restrictions, good reliability and economic feasibility [8].

In addition, a study developed by the team showed that an underwater energy storage system with 80 spheres

In the Bag: Energy bags like this 5-meter-diameter one, from Thin Red Line Aerospace, of Canada, could be used to store electricity underwater as compressed air.
