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For example, if we have a buffer storage tank with a volume of 1000 liters (further on, the mass of 1 liter of water is assumed to be equal to 1 kg) and we heat it to 50°C, then it will accumulate heat energy  $1000 \times 50 = 50,000 \text{ kcal} = 0.05 \text{ Gcal} = 58 \text{ kWh}$ .

TES Tank Sized for 4 hours of full cooling capacity storage as compared to 10 to 15 minutes of current common practice. i.e. if a data center with IT load of 4,000 kw would typically require 5,200 to 5,600 KW (1.3 to 1.4 x IT load) of cooling capacity and hence the thermal storage capacity should be  $4 \text{ Hrs.} \times 5,600 \text{ kw} = 22,400 \text{ kwh}$  or 6,370 Ton-Hr.
