According to a video released by Goodyear, the tire is designed to produce electricity using a thermoelectric material that turns heat into electricity, and by using a piezoelectric material - a material that can generate an electrical charge when it is stretched or put under stress.

The high calorific value (28-37 MJ kg⁻¹) and low mineral content of tires make them a valuable potential energy source. However, converting waste tires into energy or energy storage materials through methods such as incineration or combustion can also result in significant environmental issues.
