However, pumped storage, an energy storage technology with water as the medium, is limited by water resources and mature technology; thus, it has limited cost reduction space and a relatively slow cumulative power capacity growth rate. By 2035, the cumulative power capacity will account for only 8.9% (pre-Ef) to 27.8% (pre-Co).

The storage of electrical energy has become an inevitable component in the modern hybrid power network due to the large-scale deployment of renewable energy resources (RERs) and electric vehicles (EVs) [1, 2]. Therefore, under the H-S-Ma scenario of a minimum continuous discharge time and maximum power transmission energy, China's optimal energy storage capacity will grow the fastest, with an average annual growth rate of 17.6%. The larger the power transmission capacity is, the smaller the cumulative power capacity of energy storage.
