

Wellington buffer storage tank

Calculation of the buffer storage tank consists of determining the accumulative capacity of the stored volume of water. The accumulative capacity of water is characterized by heat capacity equal to $4.187 \text{ kJ} \cdot \text{kg}^{-1} \cdot \text{C}^{-1}$. This means that to heat one kilogram of water by 1°C , it is necessary to supply the amount of heat equivalent to 4.187 kJ or ...
