

# What are china s new energy storage sites

Outlook for Energy Storage Installations in 2024. Looking ahead to 2024, TrendForce anticipates a robust growth in China's new energy storage installations, projecting a substantial increase to 29.2 gigawatts and 66.3 gigawatt-hours. This marks a remarkable surge of approximately 46% and 50% year-on-year, indicative of a period of high growth.

Developing energy storage is an important step in China's transition from fossil fuels to renewable energy, while mitigating the effect of new energy's randomness, volatility and intermittence on the grid and managing power supply and demand, he said.

As of the end of 2023, China had 86 GW of energy storage in place, with pumped storage accounting for 59.3% and battery storage 40.6%. As battery costs have been dropping significantly, there has been a boom in the adoption of battery energy storage, leading to a significant uptick in new projects.

China's energy storage sector nearly quadrupled its capacity from new technologies such as lithium-ion batteries over the past year, after attracting more than 100 billion yuan (US\$13.9 billion) in direct investment over the past couple of years.

In terms of BESS infrastructure and its development timeline, China's BESS market really saw take off only

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recently, in 2022, when according to the National Energy Administration (China) and China Energy Storage Alliance (CNESA) data, new energy storage capacity reached 13.1GW, more than double the amount reached in 2021.

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
