An inappropriate grounding method may help an L-G fault to reduce the voltage in the faulted conductor to almost zero, thereby highly increasing the line to ground voltage of the unaffected line, compromising the safety of personnel and equipment. Another grounding dependent factor affecting safety is the development of common-mode-voltage (CMV).
