So, What Is Battery Storage Capacity? Battery storage capacity refers to the maximum amount of electricity a unit can store when fully charged. Not all batteries can be safely operated until fully discharged. For example, you should never discharge a lead acid battery below 50% of its total capacity, as you will shorten its lifespan.

Each 12-volt lead-acid battery contains six (6)cells, and each cell contains a mixture of sulfuric acid and water. Each cell has a positive terminal and a negative terminal. When the battery is generating power, it is discharging as it does so.

These are the most common batteries, the ones with the familiar cylindrical shape. There are no batteries that actually store electrical energy; all batteries store energy in some other form.

When the battery is discharged, the sulfuric acid reacts with the lead to create lead sulfate and hydrogen ions. This releases electrons, which flow through an external circuit to power a device. When the battery is charged, the reaction is reversed, with the lead sulfate and hydrogen ions recombining to create sulfuric acid and lead.

The electrolyte is an aqueous solution of sulfuric acid. The value of E° for such a cell is about 2 V. Connecting three such cells in series produces a 6 V battery, whereas a typical 12 V car battery contains six cells in series. When treated properly, this type of high-capacity battery can be discharged and recharged many times over.
