

# What does electric energy storage rely on

So-called pumped storage hydropower--also known as water batteries--can hold huge amounts of renewable energy for months at a time. This storage is very important. ... Off-river pumped hydro energy storage. In 2021, the U.S. had 43 operating pumped hydro plants with a total generating capacity of about 22 GW and an energy storage capacity of 553 GWh. They make up 93% of utility-scale storage in the country. Globally, pumped hydro's share of energy storage is even higher - about 99% of energy storage volume.
