This paper argues that the cost of storage is driven in large part by the duration of the storage system. It's important to note that battery prices vary based on the type of equipment, product availability, and location. In fact, based on the NREL's breakdown, the actual equipment (battery, inverter, and balance of system) costs around \$7,400 -- 39% of the total cost of a standalone project -- while soft costs like supply chain costs, installation labor, taxes, permitting/inspection ...

The global market for these systems -- essentially large batteries -- is expected to grow tremendously in the coming years. A study by the nonprofit LDES (Long Duration Energy Storage) Council pegs the long-duration energy storage market at between 80 and 140 terawatt-hours by 2040. Although using energy storage is never 100% efficient--some energy is always lost in converting energy and retrieving it--storage allows the flexible use of energy at different times from when it was generated.
