

# Zambia lead acid energy storage battery life

Despite an apparently low energy density--30 to 40% of the theoretical limit versus 90% for lithium-ion batteries (LIBs)--lead-acid batteries are made from abundant low-cost materials and nonflammable water-based electrolyte, while manufacturing practices that operate at 99% recycling rates substantially minimize environmental impact (1).

Overview of Lead-Acid and Lithium Battery Technologies Lead-Acid Batteries. Lead-acid batteries have been a staple in energy storage since the mid-19th century. These batteries utilize a chemical reaction between lead plates and sulfuric acid to store and release energy. There are two primary categories of lead-acid batteries:
